### ROCKY MOUNTAIN COLLEGIATE CYCLING CONFERENCE (RMCCC) CONFERENCE FINALS at HARTMAN ROCKS in GUNNISON, CO

**DIRECTIONS TO HARTMAN ROCKS:** Coming from either the east or west on Highway 50, turn on Goldbasin Road (Highway 3) proceeding south at the Hartman Rocks Recreation Area sign. Travel on Highway 3 for approximately 3 miles and turn right into the Hartman Rocks Base Area. **PLEASE NOTE:** Restrooms and water are available at the pavilion. **LODGING:** Camping will be allowed on BLM Property over the cattle guard starting above "Kill Hill" (follow signs). BE PREPARED. Gunnison is at 7700' and is notorious for early season harsh weather. Expect cold temperatures and be prepared for the possibility of snow.

We will be providing **indoor camping accommodations** inside the WSC College Union (Kebler Ballroom) on Friday, October 19 and Saturday, October 20. The ballroom is a large, open area in our College Union that is heated with bathroom facilities and a games room in close proximity. Please bring blankets, sleeping bags, and pillows as if you were camping outdoors.

### RACE COURSE INFORMATION

**XC Course:** The XC Course will start at the base area and climb up Jack's Trail. It continues above the base area proceeding right around a loop (former Rage in the Sage Course) until it meets a newly developed trail called Top of the World. The loop continues on by connecting Fenceline, Gateway, Josie's, Rocky Ridge and Beck's Trail. "A" Class Riders: 3 laps. "B" Class Riders: 2 laps. "C" Class Riders: 1 lap. The last lap exits Beck's Trail proceeding straight ahead to The Notch and finishes down Backbone. These trails are rolling and technical featuring loose granite and fire roads. There will be feed zones for A and B riders between Beck's and Top of the World.

**DH Course:** The DH Course will be featured on the V-Drop, which is fast, technical, with rocky & loose, flat turns. There will be a show-time booter and some pedaling, so get on the trainers; you will have to earn your turns.

**STXC Course:** The STXC Course will be located in close proximity to the base area. It will be fast and furious!

**SUPER D:** The Super D Course will start at Rattlesnake, to Beck's, The Notch, and Backbone. It will be fast with challenging, technical terrain, especially on Rattlesnake.

## RACE REGISTRATION

Race registration will be open from 7:00-11:00 am on Saturday, October 20 and from 7:00-8:30 am on Sunday, October 21 at the pavilion located at the base area of Hartman Rocks. **PLEASE NOTE:** Registration for STXC closes 30 minutes before the start of the STXC race. Registration for the DH and Super D closes at 11 am.
