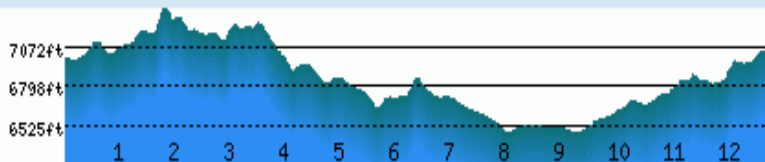

From North: Exit right off 156b (North Gate). Enter Academy, cont. West on Northgate. Left on Parade Loop, parking on left.

Course: 12.61 mi, rolling, Point to Point (20 min. return ride to start)

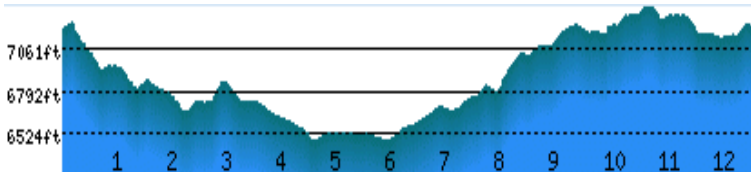

Location: From South: Exit 150 off I-25 (S. Gate/N. Academy). Turn west (towards Mountains). Enter Academy, cont. North on Stadium Blvd. Left on end onto North Gate Blvd. Turn left into upper cadet field parking. Use Caution as you are on the race / charity ride course.

From North: Exit right off 156b (North Gate). Enter Academy, cont. West on Northgate. Turn left in upper cadet field parking. Use caution.

Course: 12.75 mi, hilly, classic loop. "Similar to '86 Worlds course." <http://www.mapmyride.com/ride/united-states/co/colorado-springs/513636966>
Due to possible high wind conditions, consider bringing an alternative to deep dish wheels—last year wind gusts were as high as 30mph.

Feed Zone: On uphill by finish. No neutral feeds. USAC rules apply. Course open to traffic. During race, you are in rolling enclosure. Off the back obey "rules of the road". Great road surface. 39x23 recommended.

This is your warning—cross the yellow line, you are disqualified!

Registration: Pre-register and save \$10 "day of" late fee.

Opens at 5:15, closes 30 minutes prior to race start. Do not wait until the last minute to register; we filled most fields last year early on race day. Field Limit of 125 riders -- Cat 5 and Women's Open Field limits at 75
Held rain or shine—sorry no refunds for any reason

Support: No wheel vans at this time. If that changes, info will be published on race day. This is a very smooth, clean course.

Chaney King: She was a lively, beautiful 20 year old who was tragically killed in a car accident on January 18, 2003. She loved life, her family, her friends, and the Air Force Academy. What Chaney possessed in her short life was the drive, determination and perseverance to achieve her dreams even when obstacles were in her way. When she wasn't accepted into the Air Force Academy, she refused to give up her dream and pursued other ways to get in. This was her first contact with the Falcon Foundation. They awarded her a scholarship to a prep school, which she took full advantage of at Northwestern Preparatory School. This resulted in her appointment to the Academy as part of the class of 2005. As a member of Squadron 13, she served as honor clerk at the time of the accident. She was also a member of the women's lacrosse team and founder of a mentoring/support group for female cadets and female officers. Chaney stated many times that without the Falcon Foundation and Northwestern Prep, she would not have succeeded at USAFA. So, it is with gratitude that we dedicate this ride to the Falcon Foundation and their belief in dreams, youth and the Academy - and to Chaney whose life was rich with inspiration.
